

Junior Exchange to Aurillac



Aurillac is the county town of Le Cantal in the Auvergne region of central southern France. In June, students in Year 8 take part in an annual exchange with the Collège La Jordanne in Aurillac, where they stay for a week with host families whose children come to stay at Worth School in May.

During the week our students take part in a range of exciting activities which typically include:

- a visit to the Gouffe de Padirac cave and its underground river
- a guided tour around historic Aurillac
- a visit to the nearby Volcano park
- go-karting
- ice-skating
- canoeing and kayaking on the River Lot

Our students are naturally exposed to the French language each day, and the exchange is a wonderful opportunity for them to develop their speaking and listening skills far beyond what is possible in the classroom. A team of Worth teachers is on hand to provide pastoral and educational support.
