



## Music Scholarship

Candidates applying for Year 7

Scholarships are awarded for choral and/or instrumental excellence to outstanding candidates able to offer two (or more) instruments (voice is acceptable as an instrument) to Grade 4 standard (*first instrument*) and Grade 2 standard (*second instrument*).

Candidates applying for Year 9

A number of scholarships are awarded annually to outstanding candidates able to offer two (or more) instruments (voice is acceptable as an instrument) to Grade 6 standard (*first instrument*) and to Grade 3 standard (*second instrument*), and this award also includes free tuition on two instruments.

Candidates applying for Year 12

Students are expected to play their first and second instrument (voice is acceptable as an instrument) to Grade 8 standard (first instrument) and Grade 6 standard (second instrument). Students will also complete a written Music Paper and the General Paper. There will be a scholarship interview.

All candidates for scholarships will be expected to do some aural tests and sight reading. Pre-audition appointments should be made during the autumn term prior to the year of entry. There will be a chance to ask the Director of Music and his colleagues questions and to look around the department during the pre-audition. Candidates are also required to provide a portfolio of certificates and references.
