



Music Scholarship

Candidates applying for Year 7

Scholarships are awarded for choral and/or instrumental excellence to outstanding candidates able to offer two (or more) instruments (voice is acceptable as an instrument) to Grade 4 (*first instrument*) and Grade 2 (*second instrument*).

Candidates applying for Year 9

A number of scholarships are awarded annually to outstanding candidates able to offer two (or more) instruments (voice is acceptable as an instrument) to Grade 6 (*first instrument*) and to Grade 3 (*second Instrument*), and this award also includes free tuition on two instruments.

Candidates applying for Year 12:

Students are expected to play their first and second instrument (voice is acceptable as an instrument) and to do some aural tests and sight reading. Students will also complete a written Music Paper and the General Paper. There will be a scholarship interview.

Pre-audition appointments should be made during the autumn term prior to the year of entry. There will be a chance to ask the Director of Music and his colleagues questions and to look around the department during the pre-audition. Candidates are also required to provide a portfolio of certificates and references.
