** Calculators

Years 7-11: Casio fx83GT-plus calculator. The Mathematics dept. requires all pupils to have the same model of calculator, this can be obtained through the Mathematics dept. at the start of term (the cost will be charged to your account and usually works out cheaper than buying elsewhere).

Years 12-13: In the Sixth form we are currently in a state of changing the calculator we recommend, so we do not want pupils to buy any graphic calculator until they arrive at Worth. The calculator they will be issued with will be suited to the course they are taking and will be at the best price we can get from the suppliers. In the past we have had pupils arriving with an expensive calculator that was not necessarily suitable.

Boarding students are asked not to bring too much casual clothing as there is limited wardrobe and drawer space for non-uniform items.

Overseas boarding students should bring electrical adaptors, if required.

Parents must ensure that ALL clothes and ALL personal possessions are clearly named before arriving at school. All clothing must be marked with a sew in, printed or woven name tape (which should be ordered well in advance) and not with marking ink. Please do not use iron-on tapes as these fall off easily. Clothing should be checked for name tapes before the start of each term. All footwear must be clearly and indelibly marked. The school cannot take responsibility for any items that are not marked.

For boarding pupils, please send at least 24 spare name tapes for the Matron's use, in case any additional items are purchased at school during the term.

Please note that a charge of 75pence per label will be made if items of clothing are brought into school unmarked.

Name tapes can be ordered from Sussex Uniforms Ltd.

Please note that any unnamed items of clothing which are unclaimed will be passed to a local charity at the start of each term.

Parents need to obtain those items marked with * from Sussex Uniforms. The rest of the items may be purchased anywhere.
